

Software Disks on Reserve: Visual Studio, SQL Server CS 112A, 112B, 112D, 150A, 152A(150P)

You can check if the software disks are on the shelf at the libraries. Go to the library search page

The following screen will give you a list of classes. Unfortunately the library does not reference all of the disks and classes properly.

Visual Studio/Visual Basic. Use CS 112B as the search. You should see 4 listings for Visual Studio 2008 at the Rosenberg library and 2 listings for MSDN Library for Visual 2008 as the Downtown library. These are all Visual Studio 2008 Pro discs.
