Below is part of a handout I prepared for my students on how to register for MyMathLab. Feel free to use any part of it.

I. Requirements for Using MyMathLab

To use MyMathLab on a computer, the computer must have:

PC: Windows XP, Window Vista, or Windows 7.

Internet Explorer 7 or 8 (6 okay with XP) or Firefox 2 or 3.

Mac: OS X 10.4 - 10.6.

Safari 3 or 4 or Firefox 2 or 3.

Mac and PC: In your browser,

Javascript must be turned on.

Cookies must be allowed.

Pop-up windows must be allowed, at least for the course compass/mymathlab websites.

The latest version of Adobe Flash must be installed.

On campus, the computers in the Math Lab, Library, and the labs for several programs including AASP and APASS can use MyMathLab.

II. How to Register for MyMathLab

You must register online. You will need:

1. A MyMathLab student access code. It is provided in the MyMathLab kit or is provided on

your computer screen with an online purchase (credit card needed).

- 2. The Course ID number: as given in class
- 3. A valid email address use your college email address.
- 4. The CCSF zip code: 94112

You register as follows:

1. Go to http://www.coursecompass.com

2. In the top right corner, under students, click the Register button.

If you have not used MyMathLab before, select Get access to a new course.
