

These items will be needed for the first class:

- Protective gloves. If you have an allergy to latex use vinyl or nitrile. For your health and safety have as minimum of contact between potential absorption of materials through skin, breathing, etc. Barrier items are essential to keep a distance between materials that need to stay clean and messy items. *Some available to purchase in class.
- Pencil, notebook. All students must take notes on lectures and demonstrations.
- Wax paper. Minimum of 2-3 rolls.
- Selection of oil painting brushes: rounds, flats, filberts.

To purchase in class:

- *Plexiglas, 1/16". Sizes can be: 8 x 10", 9 x 12", 12 x 16" and 15 x 20". If you purchase plexi or acrylic from other sources, make sure it is no thicker than 1/16"
- *Clear 5 to 7.5 mil acetate* with oak tag* backing.
- *Various printmaking papers: Rives BFK, Arches Cover, Arches 88 suggested for water based inks. Check with instructor for other compatible papers.

These items will be needed immediately after the first class:

- Sharpie extra fine marker.
- Cuticle sticks or bamboo skewers.
- Pkg. of cotton swabs (Q-tips).
- Portfolio to store prints, proofs and paper safely on your shelf.

Materials needed according to assignment schedule:

- Watercolors: pan or individual tubes (some available in class).
- Watercolor brushes.
- Stencil materials.
- Collograph materials; 151B students should bring their own collograph supplies.
- Optional: tempera, Createx pure pigments (some available in class).
- Other materials will be announced in class as needed.
