Problems:

1. Analyze the excerpted paragraph and explain why the investigation of the abduction phenomenon is <u>not</u> scientific. (500 words minimum) [40 points]

"Careful study of books written during the 1980's clearly shows a progression of details lacking in earlier accounts. What they do *not* show is that most UFO researchers who wrote these books had little or no recognition that the hypnosis process often establishes a telepathic link between the hypnotizer and the person who is hypnotized. Many of these researchers act as the hypnotists themselves, or at least closely monitor the hypnosis sessions. Even those researchers who are well-educated and experienced do not seem to recognize the possibility that they might be retrieving information from their witnesses that fits into their *own* theories about the meaning of the UFO abduction phenomenon and the motives of the abductors. Thus, one veteran researcher would retrieve accounts that the abductors have the best of motives, as claiming to have been assigned by some vague "higher power" to help the human race evolve into greater spiritual consciousness."*
