Ask three or four classmates these questions. Talk with students from different countries. Take notes.

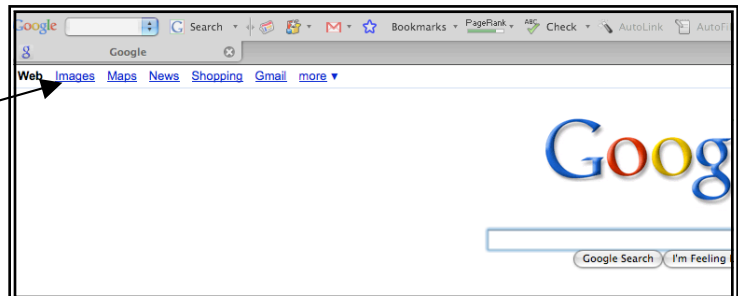
1. What country are you from?
