2-3: Defining Levels Of Instruction

Levels of Instruction

- Depth of instruction
- Three levels
 - Level I Basic knowledge
 - Level II Competent
 - Level III Highly proficient

Level I- Basic Knowledge

- Student acquires new information
- Instructor is primary information source
 - Emphasizing "what," "where," etc.
- Evaluations

Level II - Competent

- Student applies learned knowledge and skills
- Instructor as information source
 - Presentation emphasis is switched from "what" to "how" and "why"
- Evaluations

Level III - Highly Proficient

- Apply knowledge and skills learned earlier to new situations/problems
- Instructor monitors and facilitates
- Students develop, implement, and evaluate solutions
- Evaluations
