Purpose of a Skills Sheet

- Provides sequence and detail
- Step-by-step operations for completing a task
- Breaks down a task



Purpose of a Skills Sheet

- Operational step
 - Smallest step
 - Production order
 - Also known as "performance units"
- Key points
 - Safety related
 - Knowledge units
 - Information that aids the student in performing an operation



Skills Sheet Format

- Task title
- Page divided into two columns
- Left column lists Operations
 - Use action verbs
- Right column lists Key Points
 - Cautions and warnings
 - Safety factors
 - Essential conditions



Test Instrument Components

- Performance objectives
- Rating factors
 - Performance accuracy
 - Time standard
 - Care in handling tools and equipment
- Clear directions
- Many different correct formats
